Anti Bullying Week

We are proud that our behaviour at Tillingbourne is good but we always strive to be even better.

This week we have had a whole school focus on Anti-bullying. This has included learning about how we combat bullying and sharing our anti-bullying policy. The children have also made friendship bookmarks for each other.

Furthermore we have taken this opportunity to work with the children to create a traffic light guide to behaviour. This clearly

identifies what good behaviour looks like and the specific rewards that this can achieve. (**Green Behaviour**).

The traffic light guide also shows '**orange behaviour**' and '**red behaviour**' and the resulting consequences. The aim of this guide is that children are supported to make the right choices and recognise that, when mistakes are made, the consequences are part of working together to get things back on track.

Agreeing the traffic lights has generated some very interesting discussions and, as ever, our children demonstrated how thoughtful, caring and reflective they can be.
